DIY MAGIC UNPOPPABLE BUBBLES

YOU'LL NEED:

1 cup water



1 tbsp granulated sugar2 tbsp liquid dish soapStraw

Step 1: Take 1 cup of water and add in the sugar. Mix until the sugar dissolves.

Step 2: Add the liquid dish soap and mix again carefully.

Step 3: Spread a little bit of the solution around on your counter or table. Take your straw and swish it around in the cup. Place the end close to your counter and blow gently to make a bubble. Swish your straw in the bubble solution again and gently stick it inside the first bubble. Blow a second bubble.

Step 4: See how many bubbles you can make!
